Bremerton FSC Rules Governing Tests

1. All checks should be made payable to Bremerton FSC. Non BFSC members add \$25 per test. A \$25 NSF will be charged on all checks returned for non sufficient funds.

2. Non BFSC members must have a permission letter from their home club in order to test (TR 3.08 of the USFS Rulebook). Permission letter from the home club test chair may be emailed to the BFSC chair at bfscstestchair@gmail.com. First priority will be given to BFSC full members. Second priority will be given to BFSC Associate members.

3. In order to participate in a testing session, the skater must be a member in good standing of US Figure Skating.

4. Test fees are non refundable. If a test is applied for and not taken, the funds cannot be refunded, with the exception of documented cases of illness or injury preventing the skater from participating. In such cases, a doctor's written note must be presented to the test chair. In the case of a documented exception, the fees paid will be applied to a future test session.

5. Test fees will not be carried over to the next test date if a skater is unable to advance to a Freeskate test due to a retry mark on a Moves in the Field test or Dance test. If BFSC is unable to hold a test session or a skater has to be placed on a waiting list, the fees will be carried over to the next test session.

6. A coaches signature is required on all test applications. The applications must be received by the test chair 2 weeks prior to the test session date. Late applications will be charged a \$25 late fee and will be placed on a waiting list. Any late applications will only be scheduled if time permits. If time does not permit, the application and fees will be forwarded to the next test session.

7. It is the responsibility of the skater and/or parent to fill out the form completely and submit it with the appropriate fees by the due date. Skaters will not be placed on the final test schedule until all forms and fees have been received by the test chair. Should the test session fill before the deadline, all other test applications will be held and given first priority at the next scheduled test session.

8. All participants must bring a food item(s) for the judges and skater's hospitality table. These items need to be given to the test chair prior to the start of the test session. If you cannot bring a hospitality item, please include \$5 with your application to cover your obligation.

9. The skating order and test schedule will be posted on the BFSC bulletin board, website and emailed to all testers and instructors. Please arrive for your scheduled test at least 30 minutes prior to the start of your test. It is the skater's responsibility to know when they are testing.
